

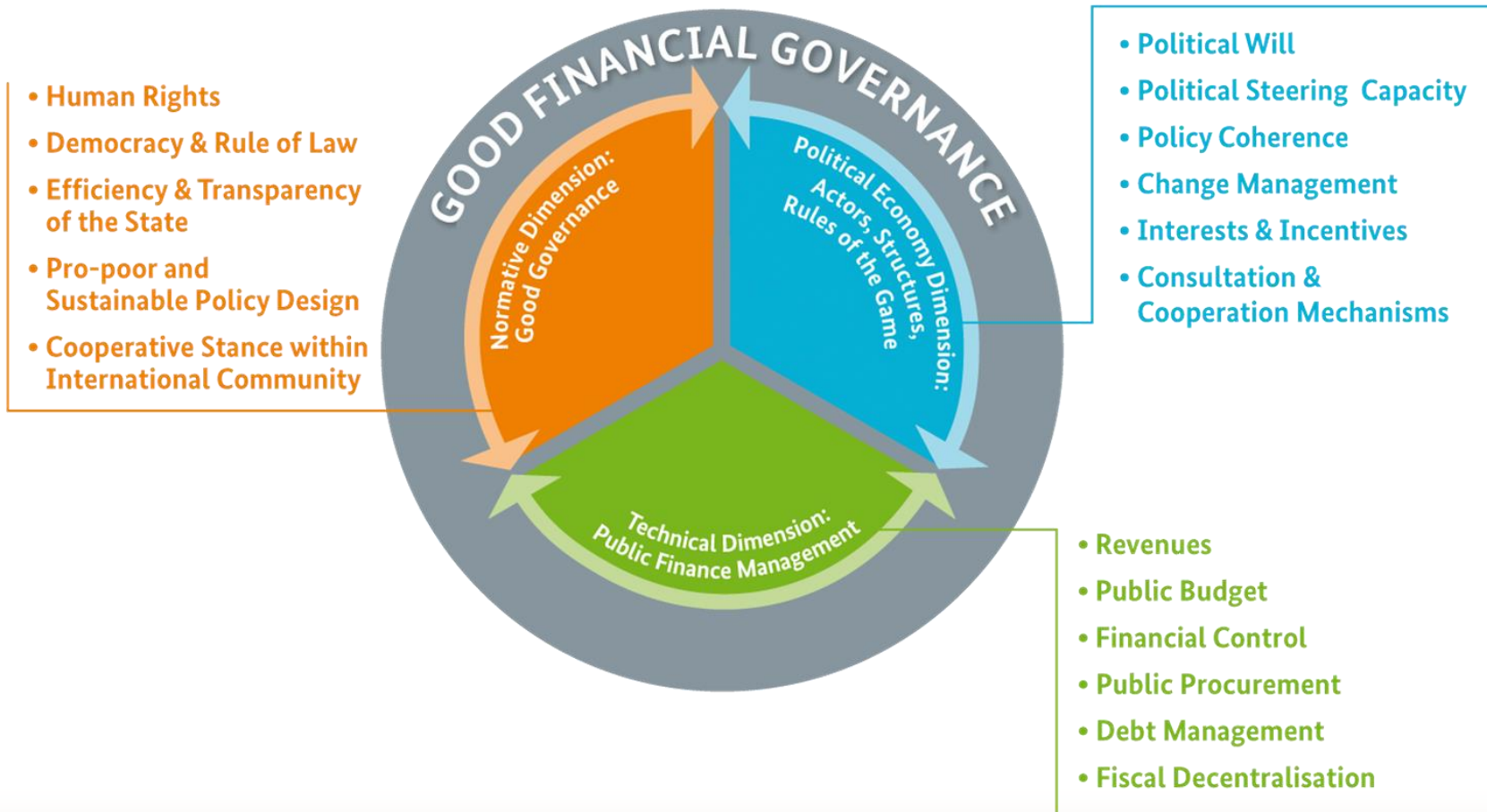

# Challenges From DP Perspective Related supporting PAC Ghana to participate in Regional/Continental Meetings

- ☐ Speaker of Parliament reducing the agreed number of PAC Participants for Regional/Continental events
- ☐ Restricted participation in AFROPAC Meetings for PAC members and Secretariat eg. Only the clerk and not deputy clerk.
- ☐ Knowledge transfer after AFROPAC/WAAPAC Meetings to other members of PAC who could not attend.
