Benefits and Impacts of the PFM-RF Assessment

- PFM report helps in providing information that will help monitoring and evaluation of SDGs achievements -independent voice on the challenges facing the global community in planning and implementing the SDGs and reporting on their progress
- Recommendations and follow-ups in the PFM report ensures improvements in the PFM Systems
- The tool enables to dig deeper to the root of the PFM Systems challenges-The tool highlights weaknesses for each department or entity
- It allows for a comparison across key and primary stakeholders



Challenges

- ➤ Covid-19 pandemic -Accessibility to stakeholders was a challenge since majority of them had been ordered to work from home.
- Analysis of the root causes was hampered by limited timelines-Some clients took a long time to respond while some were unable to justify the responses given.
- ➤ Future Will Parliament discuss the report given the current challenge with performance audit reports? If they will discuss, will Parliament see the SAI perspective on the PFM process?

Conclusion

- PFM RF provides an "in-depth, country-level, politically informed understanding of how PFM systems work."
- PFM RF is a good tool as it gives in-depth details on underlying reasons for poor performance/ significant PFM weaknesses, unlike other assessments. It provides a basis to begin to identify a road map to PFM reform that is contextually/ problem-driven.
- The proportion of budgets being allocated to SDGs demonstrated level of commitment towards achieving national priorities in line with the SDGs
